
What are some examples of this sort of technology in action? Any results or stories to share?

A Fortune 500 global power company missed a production guarantee resulting in liquidated damages. To prevent oversights like this, they championed a new approach with Document Intelligence.

- Once documents were loaded into the platform, they were able to review over 20,000 pages of dense content in three days.
- They found and extracted all production guarantee clauses for continual obligation management tracking.
- With all the important documents automatically organized and categorized, they were able to build a robust digital ecosystem integrating data from the source of truth (the governing document) with other business systems for ongoing insights

In another example that really shows the speed of the platform; a customer loaded 9,000 leases in a day and a half and the platform extracted both vertical and horizontal Pughs in a matter of minutes (literally).

In both cases, these quickly obtained insights provided by the Document Intelligence platform helped end-users advise key stakeholders on critical business decisions worth millions of dollars.
